

SALEM TOWNSHIP  
FIVE MILE ROAD PAVING PROJECT  
SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

RESOLUTION DECLARING TENTATIVE INTENT TO PROCEED  
WITH PROJECT AND SETTING PUBLIC HEARING

Five Mile Road, between Napier Road and Chubb Road, is located in Salem Township's Industrial District and is currently a dirt and gravel road and use of Five Mile Road by heavy industrial trucks creates mud and dust on Five Mile Road and such road without paving and improvements may adversely affect the health, safety, and welfare of adjoining properties and residents, and the fair market value of adjoining properties.

By way of this Resolution, the Salem Township Board of Trustees desires to proceed to establish a special assessment district to finance the project for the paving and improvement of Five Mile Road, between Napier Road and Chubb Road.

The proposed improvement ("The Project") is:

Construction of an asphalt surface and related improvements on Five Mile Road, between Napier Road and Chubb Road, to be designed and constructed for heavy vehicle loads year-round and designated to be an All-Season Road by the Washtenaw County Road Commission.

The Project is intended to provide a road improvement which provides a special benefit to industrial, commercial and residential property owners adjacent to Five Mile Road, between Napier Road and Chubb Road, which shall constitute "the District".

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Township Board determines that it tentatively declares its intent to proceed with the project, and to establish a special assessment district to finance the entire cost of the project.

2. Washtenaw County Engineers have prepared plans showing the improvement and the estimated cost of the project in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000). Such plans and cost determination are on file in the Township Clerk's office.

3. The Township Board tentatively determines that the Special Assessment District shall consist of the District, as described above.

5. The Township Board will conduct a public hearing during the regularly scheduled Township Board meeting on October 9, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Hall, for the purpose of hearing statements and objections to the Township Board's intent to proceed with the project and special assessment, to the project itself including the cost estimate, and to the District proposed as the special assessment district.

6. Notice of such hearing shall be given as provided by law in MCL 41.724, 41.724a, and 41.725.
